

## **Warsaw Rotary Club Program Policy Statement**

Weekly program presentations are intended to enhance the Four Avenues of Service for club members. Programs should be educational and focus on Club Service, Vocational Service, Community Service, and International Service.

Programs should also reflect the diverse interests of club members who serve as program chair for the week.

Since Rotary is truly an international, non-political, and non-sectarian organization, programs should not have political, religious, or strong nationalistic themes.

Representatives from political parties or any person running for office may not be a program at a Rotary meeting within six months of any election. This policy can only be changed through a special motion by the Board of Directors with agreement from the full club membership.

“Sales presentations” of goods or services can not be a program at a Rotary meeting. Presenters representing a business may be a program, but only if their presentation is strictly educational in nature and there is no attempt to gain business from the presentation.
