Requirements:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) The student must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Kosciusko County, at the time of his or her graduation from high school.2) The student must submit two letters of recommendation; one from his or her high school principal, college professor or teacher and one from a community leader or coach.3) The volunteer and community service activities of the applicant will be considered in awarding this scholarship.4) Applicants may re-apply for continuance of the scholarship.
Application Procedure:	The applicant must submit a packet consisting of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Completed KCCF Standard Application Form.- FAFSA's Student Aid Report or Tax Return.- 2 Letters of recommendation from either his or her high school principal, teacher, professor, community leader or coach.- Transcript of grades from the school most recently attended.- Recent photograph (for publicity purposes).- If awarded the scholarship the previous year, no pictures or letters required.- If awarded this scholarship, the recipient shall attend a Rotary meeting to receive his or her scholarship money.
