Hampton Fulfilling Family Tradition of Serving as Warsaw Rotary Club President

At the July 1, 2005 Rotary meeting, Cindy Hampton had her first swing of the gavel as newly elected President of the Warsaw Rotary Club. Cindy's service as President makes her the third generation in her family to serve in that position.

Hampton highlighted her goals for the next year including increasing membership to reach the 100 mark, having current Rotary members more involved, and continued success with community service projects.

Immediate Past President, Ken Locke, was thanked for his dedication to Rotary and presented with a plaque and a gift from the club. The Rotary Club's accomplishments, under Ken's leadership, were recognized. In the past year, nearly \$65,000 officially tabulated dollars were raised for various charitable projects, including a record setting \$54,000 for Salvation Army. Thirteen new members were added to Rotary for a total of 95 members. Max Courtney was mentioned as the membership growth guru. John Hall was presented with a Sagamore of the Wabash award. The Pep was revived; and the website got a fresh new look and made leaps in technology thanks to Jerry Henline. Most recently, Rotary held its first annual auction, enabling the club to award five \$1,000 scholarships to local college students.

Let's continue to work together to make the 2005-2006 year another successful year of *service above self* for the Warsaw Rotary Club.
