HOW ROTARIANS CAN HELP VICTIMS OF KATRINA

We've all see the footage.

Houses unrecognizable but for their rooftops peeking above seemingly endless water. People...thousands and thousands of people of all ages and backgrounds without shelter and in short or no supply of basic life necessities like food water and urgent medical care. Rotarians can help the people of Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama affected.

Our Past President, Ken Locke, said that cash donations are needed and can be made for the hurricane disaster relief effort through our local Salvation Army. The Ministerial Association has a point of contact in Texas ready to receive in-kind donations needed for the thousands of refugees there. On Sunday, September 4th from 3 to 8 p.m. in-kind donations will be accepted at the Marsh Supermarket parking lot in Warsaw. Donations will be accepted again on Monday from 7 a.m. until noon.

Acceptable donations include: canned goods, non-perishable food items, paper products, diapers, soap (not liquid), personal hygiene products, and new socks/underwear still in their packages for men, women and children - all sizes. No glass items please.

Donations not meeting the above requirements will be accepted, but will go to stock the pantries of local agencies like Combined Community Services and United Way.

Through our combined efforts, we can show our friends in the southern states that Warsaw, Indiana Rotarians truly live up to our motto of "service above self."
