Mobile Meals

Rotary will be delivering mobile meals the months of January and February 2006. We will be delivering six routes Monday through Thursday in January and six routes on Thursdays only (to cover for Kiwanis meetings) in February.

Helpful Guidelines:

Pick up meals at Kosciusko Community Hospital's rear entrance at the appointed time (11:15 for West Routes and 11:30 for East Routes). There are some parking spots reserved for Mobile Meals drivers. Take the long hallway to the kitchen area, which is to the right after going through double doors. You will have two containers to pick up - one for hot food and one for cold items. You will also have a book to go with the containers. The book will have names, addresses and any special instructions you'll need for delivering meals. The names and addresses are listed in order of the most efficient route. Unless you have specific instructions to do otherwise, knock on the door of the home. If the person does not hear your knock, open the door and call out loudly, "Mobile Meals." If you find no one home, DO NOT leave the meals. If you suspect a problem, call the Mobile Meals office at 267-2012.

Meals will not be delivered if the weather is so bad that schools have closed.

If you cannot deliver meals on your scheduled day, please find another Rotarian to take your route. If you can't do that, contact the Mobile Meals office at 267-2012.
